INSTRUMENT SELECTION: As we have begun our year with our first meetings, I am now asking kids to select an instrument. Students have heard or seen the options available and we will make decisions next week. Please visit <u>http://dwpoppymusic.com/elementaryband/</u> to complete the online instrument selection form. Students will not need instruments until the week of September 29. Please feel free to discuss your child's interests with me at <u>mfollett@sd35.bc.ca</u> so we can help select the instrument that will help them find the most success.

ONLINE RENTALS: Tapestry Music offers online rentals which will be delivered in time to start rehearsals. Please find more at <u>www.tapestrymusic.com</u> and click on "School Rentals". As long as you place your <u>order by Friday, September 25</u>, your instrument will be delivered to your child at school by your first with-instrument rehearsal.

IN-PERSON RENTALS: You can rent or purchase instruments and other required materials through Tapestry Music (604-538-0908), Long & McQuade Music (604-530-8704) or Tom Lee Music (604-532-8303).

ENCOURAGED: While masks are not mandatory, all wind and brass musicians (student and professional) are being encouraged to use musicians' masks, a mask with a slit 1-2" across to accommodate a mouthpiece. These can be DIY or ordered through the music retailers. Flutes are the exception and we will make flute shields to use.

THREE WARNINGS ABOUT INSTRUMENT RENTAL OR PURCHASE:

- 1. Do not buy an instrument from a non-music store! These are often poorly constructed, break very easily and cannot be repaired!
- 2. Please do not purchase the colourful plastic instruments as they are only toys. They don't work the same, break easily and quickly frustrate kids.
- 3. If you have access to a used instrument. please take it to one of the music stores below for a tune up. Any instrument in disrepair will frustrate even the most enthusiastic beginner.

## CLARINET & SAXOPHONE:

- 1 BLUE (NOT orange!) box of 10 Rico Royal #2 strength reeds. Grade 7's who played last year should be purchasing #2.5 strength reeds.
- Cork Grease & Cleaning Swab
- Saxophones also need a Neck Strap

# TRUMPET, TROMBONE, BARITONE

- Mouthpiece Brush
- Cleaning Snake
- Slide Cream
- Trumpets and Baritones need Valve Oil
- Trombones need Slide Oil

## BASSES

- Amplifier & Extension Cord
- Patch Cord
- Strap
- Digital Tuner
