THREE WARNINGS ABOUT INSTRUMENTS:

1. **Do not buy an instrument from a non-music store (especially Amazon)!** These are poorly constructed, break very easily and cannot be repaired!
2. **Please do not purchase the colourful plastic instruments** as they are only toys. They don't work the same, break easily and quickly frustrate kids.
3. Used instruments can be great but buying on Marketplace or Craigslist can be risky as they can be beyond repair. If you choose to go used independently, please, please, please! take it to one of the music stores above for a tune up during the summer. Any instrument in disrepair will frustrate even the most enthusiastic beginner.

3. **SAXOPHONES ALSO NEED A NECK STRAP**

1. **MOUTHPIECE BRUSH**
2. **CLEANING SNAKE**

4. **TRUMPETS AND BARITONES NEED VALVE OIL**
5. **TROMBONES NEED SLIDE OIL**
